### Junior Player Code of Conduct – Shellharbour City Junior Cricket Club

At Shellharbour City Junior Cricket Club, every player has a responsibility to make sure cricket is safe, fair and enjoyable for all. By being part of the club, you agree to the points below.

#### Your Rights

- Cricket should be fun, safe and enjoyable for you.
- You are valued and respected.
- Our club will listen to you and your friends when we make important decisions.

#### Respect Everyone

- Treat teammates, opponents, coaches, umpires and volunteers with respect at all times.
- Acknowledge and celebrate good play from both teams.

#### Play Fair & Be Responsible

- Follow the rules and play in the spirit of cricket.
- Accept decisions without arguing or showing poor behaviour.
- Never bully, harass or exclude others.

#### Prioritise Safety

- Put the safety and wellbeing of yourself and others first.
- Wear correct protective equipment and follow coach instructions.
- Speak up if you feel unsafe or see behaviour that is unsafe or unfair – tell a parent, a friend, or someone you trust at the club.

#### Respect Boundaries

- Use appropriate and respectful communication with other players and match officials.
- Never share photos, videos or personal information without permission.
- Respect privacy in change rooms and team spaces.
- No adult at the club should ever ask you to keep secrets from your parents or carers. If someone does, tell a parent or someone you trust straight away.

#### Zero Tolerance

- No bullying, discrimination, harassment or offensive language.
- No drugs, alcohol or vaping at any training, games or club activities.
- Behaviour that risks the safety or wellbeing of others will not be accepted.

## **What Happens if the Code is Broken**

Breaches of this Code will be managed under the club's complaints process and Australian Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children and Young People, and may result in disciplinary action. Anything that may involve a breach of the law will be reported to the police.

**By attending training, games and club events, you agree to follow this Code of Conduct. Together we make cricket safe, supportive and inclusive for everyone.**
